

The Boards of Trustees for the ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 Health Benefits Trust (ASEA Health Trust) and the Public Safety Employees Association Health and Welfare Trust (PSEA Health Trust) are pleased to announce that, effective July 1, 2019, PSEA members who are eligible employees of the State of Alaska will be eligible for coverage in the ASEA Health Trust.

The Trust will also offer coverage to COBRA qualified beneficiaries and dependents who were covered by the PSEA Health Trust prior to the transition date. PSEA is currently negotiating with the City of Fairbanks and the City of Ketchikan to provide similar access to benefits through the ASEA Health Trust.

What happens next for PSEA members who will be covered under the ASEA Health Trust:

- The ASEA Health Trust will send you an introductory letter in mid-April to provide you
 with more information about the benefits that the ASEA Health Trust provides. Watch

- The ASEA Health Trust holds an open enrollment period in May of each year. Open enrollment materials will be mailed to you in early May and you will be able to register on the website at that time. You must enroll yourself and your dependents in the ASEA Health Trust plan during open enrollment. The ASEA Health Trust offers a choice of 4 plan options. You will also have the opportunity to enroll in a Health Care Reimbursement Account.
